## from the Executive Director

Dear Friends,

Jade and Jhoel have never had it easy. After they met in a war zone during the Iraq War, they survived eight years amid hostile fighting and lived through the deadliest attack on a U.S. military base. However, both agree that being trafficked as hotel workers in North Dakota, was the most harrowing experience they had to endure. For five years, they were cheated out of their salaries, denied adequate food, housing, and transportation. Their recruiter withheld their visas and work permits creating a feeling of being trapped. Labor trafficking is often described as modern-day slavery, and Jade and Jhoel can testify they lived in slave-like conditions. These are just two of the many people 31:8 Project has assisted since its founding eight years ago. 31:8 Project seeks to prevent human trafficking by providing educational awareness and direct services to survivors of human trafficking through three program areas.

Our first area of programming is education. 31:8 Project develops and delivers specialized education, seminars, and trainings to educate and raise awareness about human trafficking, sexual exploitation and social media safety.

Our second program, Bravery Backpacks, enables law enforcement, medical personnel, and social workers to give comfort backpacks for children and youth ages 2-17 who are removed from unsafe environments and put into shelters or foster care. 31:8 Project fills the backpacks with immediate needs including hygiene products and comfort items such as a blanket and stuffed animal.

Our third program, the Human Trafficking Survivor Mentorship Program, provides victims of sex and labor trafficking with comprehensive services enabling them to move beyond the traumas caused by their trafficking and achieve various goals. The road to recovery from trafficking is long and complicated but the Mentorship Program with its emphasis on setting personal goals assists survivors in their quest for a better life.

As 31:8 Project enters 2024, our work is more vital than ever. In North Dakota, human trafficking cases continue to increase in both rural and urban areas, and victims of sex and labor trafficking seek comprehensive services from 31:8 Project. The success story highlighted above, and the various programs that we offer, would not be possible without your generous support. It only takes ONE VOICE to recognize and prevent human trafficking. Thank you for joining us in speaking up for those who cannot speak for themselves.

*The Bravery Backpacks program enables law enforcement, medical personnel, and social workers to give comfort backpacks for children and youth who are removed from unsafe environments and put into shelters or foster care. 31:8 Project fills the backpacks with immediate needs including hygiene products and comfort items such as a blanket and stuffed animal. Over 300 Bravery Backpacks were distributed in 2022 and 559 in 2023! The cost to fill one Bravery Backpack is \$75.*
